

## NONDISCRIMINATORY POLICY

### Statement of Nondiscriminatory Policy as to Students:

Kids' Ark Development Center, Inc. (school) admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. The school does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, scholarship and loan programs, and athletic and other school-administered programs.

### Publication of Statement:

The school shall include the above Statement of Nondiscriminatory Policy as to Students in its brochures and catalogues dealing with student admissions, programs, and scholarships.

The school shall include a reference to its racially nondiscriminatory policy in other written advertising that it uses as a means of informing prospective students of its programs, using the following reference: "Kids' Ark Development Center, Inc. admits students of any race, color, and national or ethnic origin."

The school shall post a notice of the above Statement of Nondiscriminatory Policy as to Students on the homepage of its website, to be clearly visible on the homepage.

As an alternative to posting the notice of the Statement of Nondiscriminatory Policy on the homepage of its website, the school may publish the notice in a newspaper of general circulation that serves all racial segments of the community. This publication shall be repeated at least once annually during the period of the school's solicitation for students or, in the absence of a solicitation program, during the school's registration period. The notice shall appear in a section of the newspaper likely to be read by prospective students and their families and it must occupy at least three column inches. It must be captioned in at least 12 point bold face type as "NOTICE OF NONDISCRIMINATORY POLICY AS TO STUDENTS," and its text must be printed in at least 8 point type.
